
PRELUDE WELCOME AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

Let us know your favorite carols and we will include them before and after and in our Christmas Eve service.






*CONFESSION and FORGIVENESS

Today we light the candle of Joy. The third candle, often pink, marks the pivot point, the halfway mark of Advent. We turn from solemnity to joy, from impatient waiting to joyful expectation, from repentance to rejoicing in the revelation of God incarnate as we prepare our gift to Christ.

We lift the light of Hope. (light the first purple candle across) Peace settled within us and we sought it among the nations,

We lift the light of Peace. (light the next purple candle clockwise)

Joy sprang forth from Your salvation and we are glad indeed.


