
St. John's Lutheran Church Third Sunday after Epiphany **January 23, 2022**

*CONFESSION and FORGIVENESS


- P In the name of the Father, and of the + Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

- C And also with you.



the holy catholic Church,


the communion of saints,
