
First Lesson ~ A reading from Proverbs 8:1-4, 22-31 after the readingR The word of the Lord.C Thanks be to God.

- P God has given us the ministry of reconciliation. Therefore, let us be reconciled to God and to one another.


Silence for reflection and self-examination.
