Tomorrow is the last day for shoebox donations. **Monetary donations are needed to help cover the \$10/box shipping cost.**

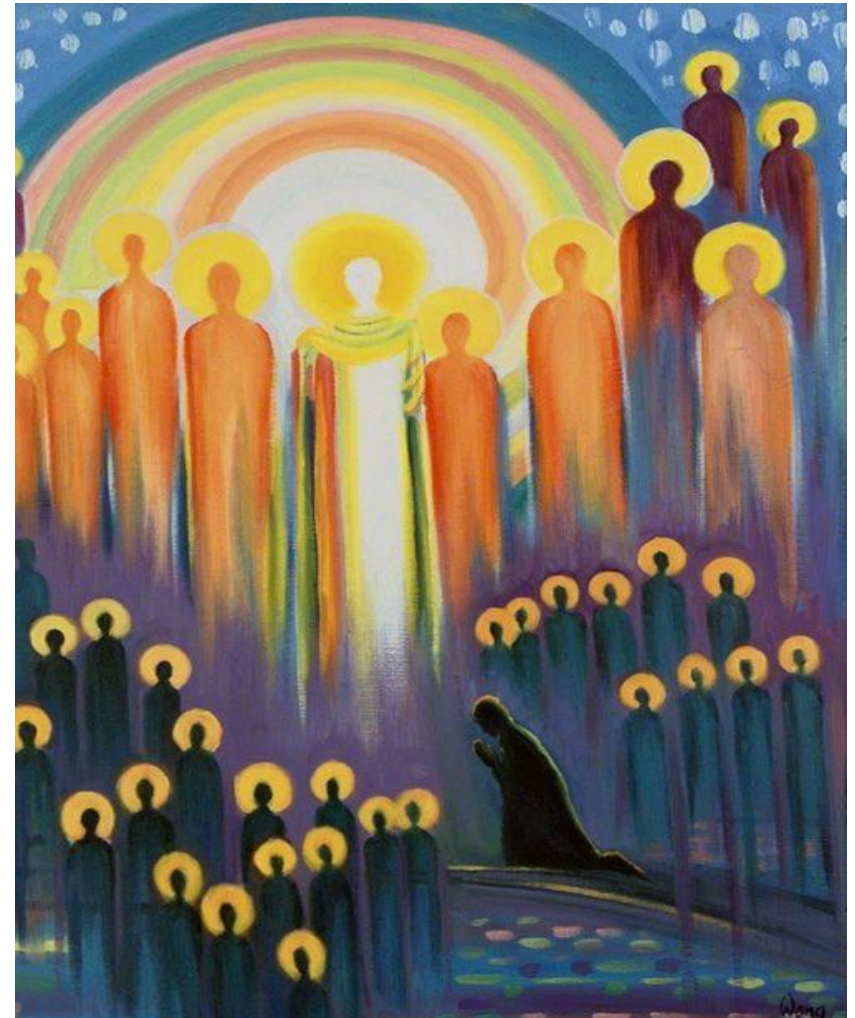
