Good news...the July/August Upper Room devotionals have finally arrived! Copies can be found in the narthex and by the elevator.


Aside from being included in each newsletter, a copy of the service schedule for those fulfilling monthly worship duties can be found on the bulletin board in the hallway between the offices.



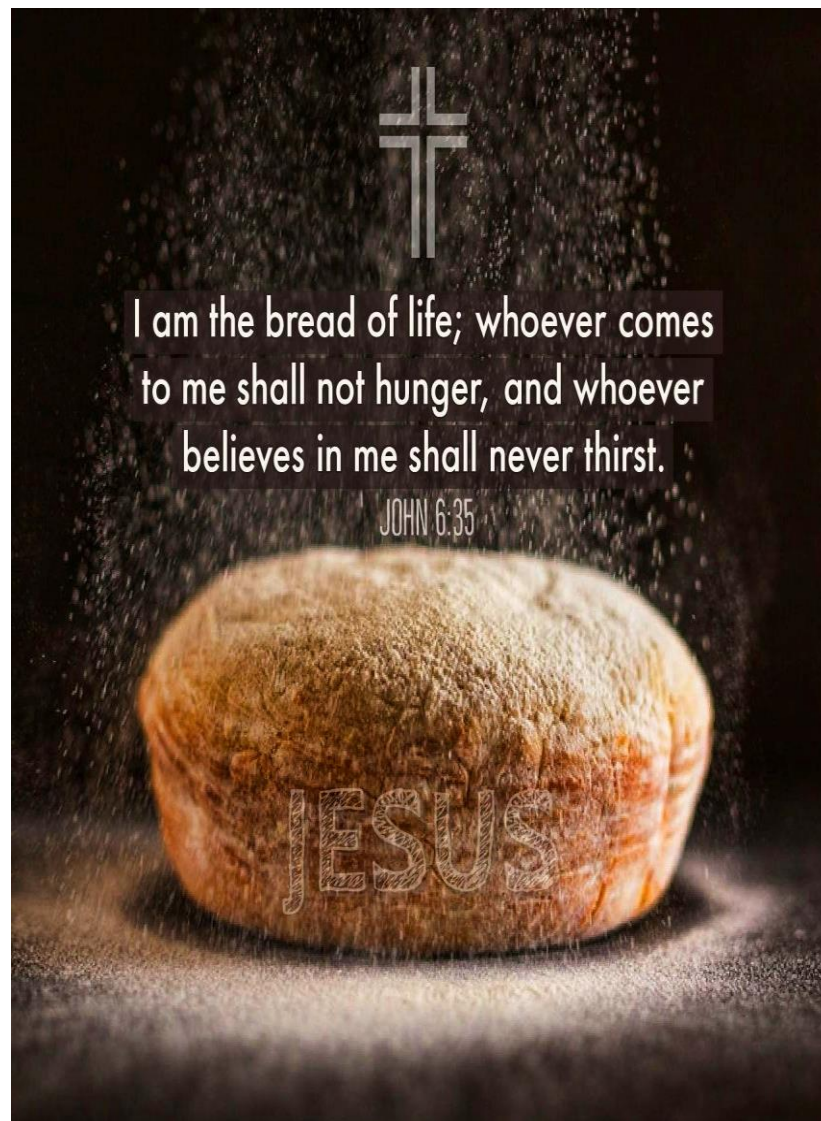
