Out of respect for the members who are making a commitment of their time and talent to serve, the goal is to have each one of the following committees become more active this year.


Please prayerfully consider serving on the Cemetery, Christian Ed, Daycare, Finance, Missions, Music and Worship, Property or Social Ministry Committees.
