
We are using the With One Voice (blue hymnal) through the end of August. There are several large print available in the narthex for those who may prefer to use them.

The Mother/Father brunch is being held in the F.H. immediately following the worship service. You are welcome to come even if you did not sign up. There will be plenty to eat.




