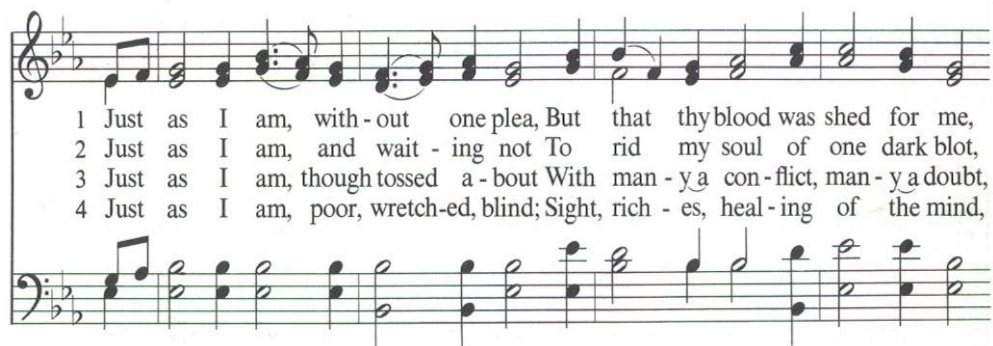
There will be a brief congregational meeting on Sunday, September 27 following the worship service. A letter with further information can be found in member mailboxes.

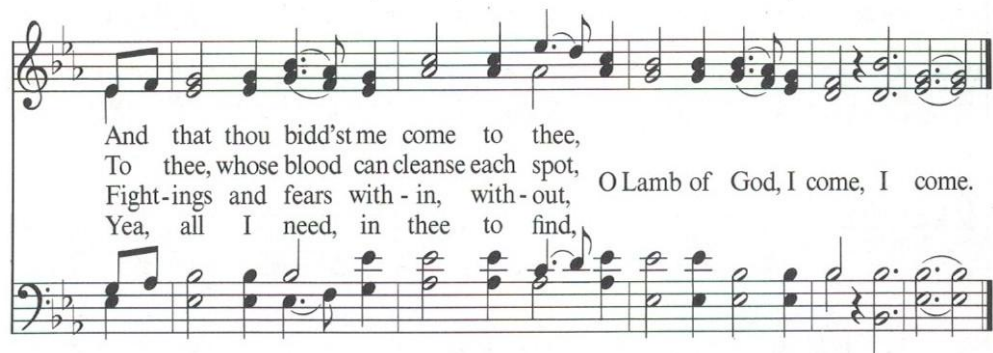

4 Just as I am, poor, wretch - ed, blind; Sight, rich - es, heal - ing of the mind,



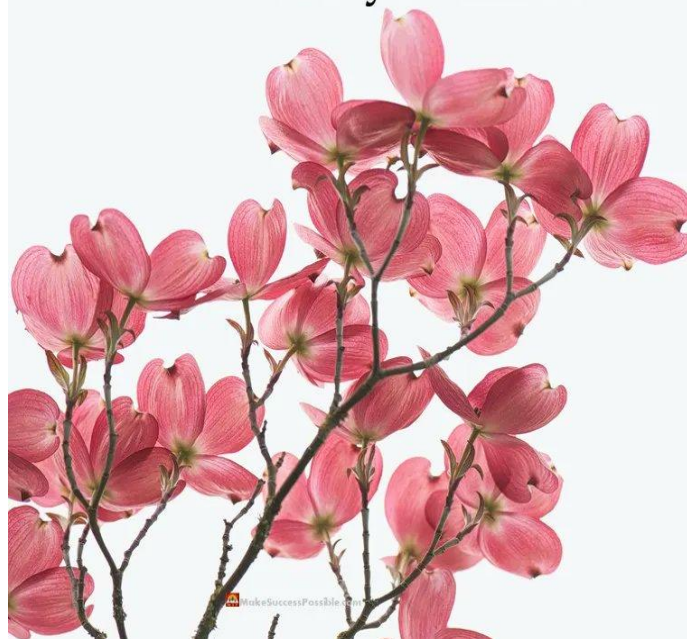
And that thou bidd'st me come to thee,
