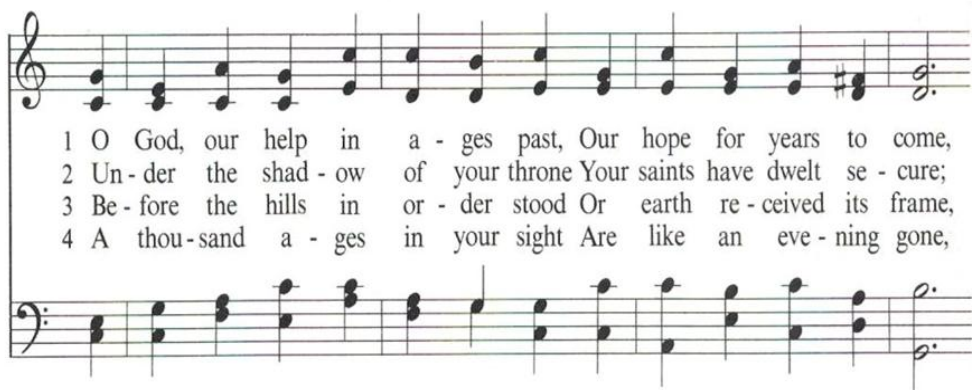
There will be a brief congregational meeting next Sunday, following the worship service. A letter with further information was sent out last week. Please contact the church office if you did not receive one.

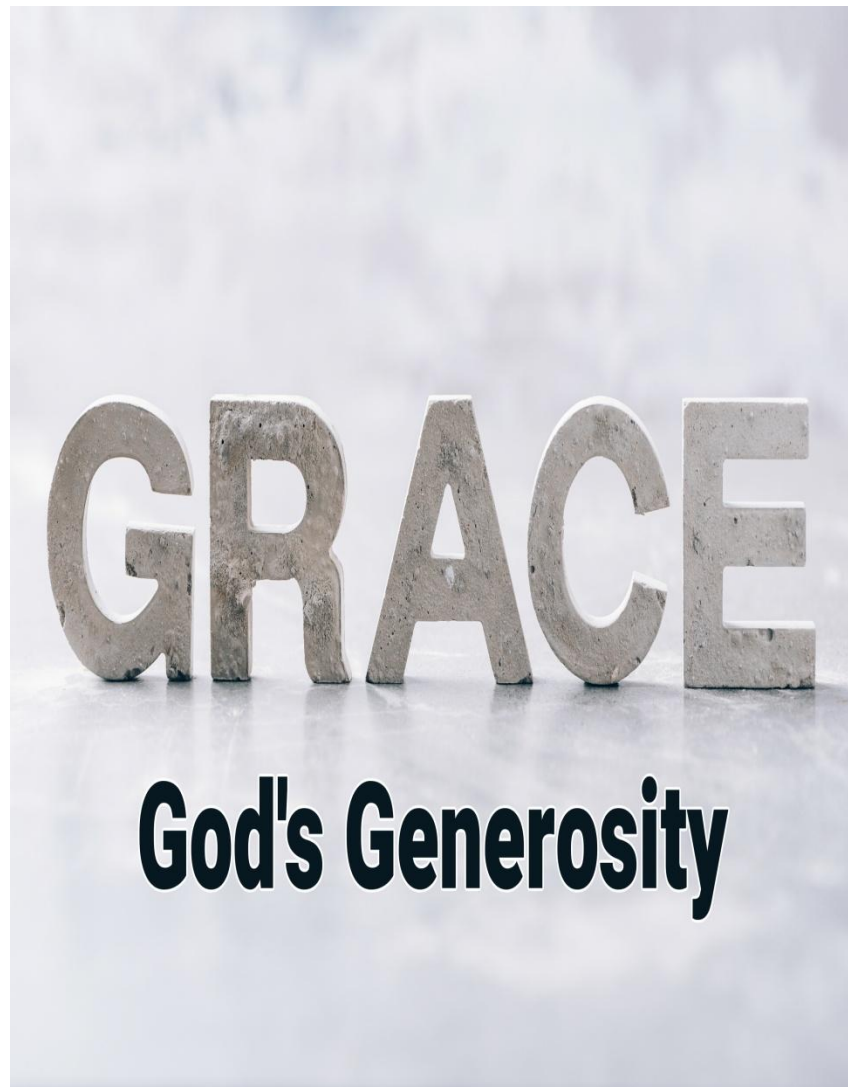
