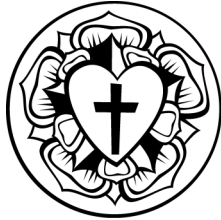

Greetings to you in the name of our Creator, Savior and Holy Spirit,

What a whirlwind these first three weeks have been! Full of meetings with all levels of Presbyterian and Lutheran committees as we forge what it will be to walk parallel yet separate paths with one pastor in one God. All kinds of people have extended warm welcome and good advice as I get settled. And what a blessing, thanks to Tom and Deb Stroup, to have a home base on 'Gospel Hill to launch this ministry.

I think God has been toughening me up to what 'weather' in Big Valley can mean. Sunday the 20th, the scheduled ordination and installation at West Kish Pres was postponed and I am sure it was one of the few times that worship at St. John's had to be cancelled. The council made this decision with great care and concern for everyone's health and safety. It was great to see everyone working together to come up with a system that will facilitate these kinds of decisions and communications in the future.

Many people I have talked to have mentioned services or activities they would like to see again, the Soup and the Word Luncheons being one. If you are interested in working on this again this year please let me know. With two churches now served by one pastor we also have the opportunity to think about how we might want to collaborate with West Kish or rotate activities during the year.

People have also made suggestions about changing or revitalizing the Worship services. I encourage any input on what you treasure in your tradition and what you think might invite others to want to participate. The worship and Christian education committees will be getting together to gather this input and shape a vision that reflects your ideas and new possibilities.

Our OT reading from the lectionary this week from Nehemiah 8, illustrates the roots for some of our worship practices stemming from traditions hundreds of years before Christ. It reflects the devotional passion, respect, contrition and joy that inspires something as simple as why and when we sit, stand or kneel. The Gospel story from annunciation and birth, to the wedding of Cana and the Resurrection reminds us to celebrate in new ways and new places.

Our binding love is in the risen Christ and our fellowship as the Church in the family of God. Let us keep this in our hearts as we both honor tradition and embrace change.

We will work out all the details once we have an idea of how many persons will be attending from both churches.

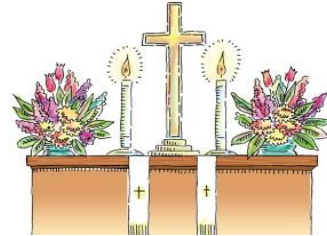
